1. Fecal occult blood test (FOBT) for those >=50 years old within the preceding 2 years OR colonoscopy screening in the past five years.	The number of adults in the clinical information system >=50 yrs with an FOBT in the past 730 days OR with a colonoscopy or referral for colonoscopy in the past 1826 days divided by the number of adults >=50 yrs in the clinical information system.	On the first workday of the month, search the clinical information system for all adults >= 50 yrs who have been screened with FOBT in the past 730 days OR with a colonoscopy or referral for colonoscopy in the past 1826 days. At the same time count the total number of adults > 50 yrs in the clinical information system.	>40%	
2. Percent of screened adults with positive stool for occult blood with notification of results and referral for colonoscopy within two weeks of the test results.	The number of adults in the clinical information system >= 50 years with an FOBT in the past 730 days with positive results and notification within two weeks of the test results that follow-up colonoscopy is needed and referral is made divided by the number of adults >=50 years with an FOBT in the past 730 days with positive results in the clinical information system.	On the first workday of the month, search the clinical information system for all adults >=50 yrs who have been screened with FOBT in the past 730 days, had positive results and got notification and referral for colonoscopy within two weeks of the test results.. At the same time count the total number of adults >= 50 yrs with a positive stool for occult blood on FOBT in the past 730 days.	>85%
